Is the most beautiful and most modern sports venue in Romania, equipped with 1850 seats, air conditioning, changing rooms, conference hall, bar, restaurant, it has a large parking lot and is centrally located in Sibiu which in 2007 was designated Sibiu European City of Culture.

**PALTINIS** is a <u>mountain resort</u> in <u>Transylvania</u>, <u>Romania</u>, 35 km south-west from <u>Sibiu</u> in the <u>Cindrel Mountains</u>.

It is situated at 1440 m altitude, being the highest resort in <u>Romania</u>. It lies in a conifer forest. It is a popular winter destination and in summer it is sought for its peacefulness. There is always snow and skiing lessons for its fresh air and for the easily accessible trekking routes.

It was founded by an association – Siebenbuergischer Karpatenverein (S.K.V.) – in 1894 and three villas from that period still exist. Currently there are 4 hotels, 6 chalets and 17 villas and an increasing number of private holiday houses.

At the entrance in the resort, there is a <u>Romanian Orthodox</u> monastery; the place where the Romanian philosopher Constantin Noicaspent the last period of his lifetime.

Formally, it is a village administered by the city of <u>Sibiu</u>, although it lies on territory that is not contiguous with the city itself.

## **Transport:**

Sibiu has its own international airport which is 5 km from Transylvania Hall. It has good links with Germany, Austria, Turkey and London Luton. <a href="http://www.sibiuairport.ro/">http://www.sibiuairport.ro/</a>

Our city is located in the center of the country. Other international airport nearby is in Cluj Napoca City (170 km from Sibiu). This cover flights to most European countries.

Also two major airports in Romania (Bucharest and Timisoara) are located 300 km from Sibiu, where flights from all over the world arrive.
